

As the weather is getting nicer I am doing more things outside like going cycling at Newscene, eating and relaxing in the garden and going for nice walks in the evenings.






We had our annual celebration of Mark Bells Birthday on 4th June, it was his 60th Birthday, we all had a Kitkat and Coke and remembered him fondly.
