I often tell new starters that I have worked every role in the organisation over the last 20 years and this is the best way to learn about how Chester Link works. Every role is essential to the smooth running of the charity, and every one of our 71 staff (as of today) plays a part in making Chester Link a great place to live in and work at.

You will see from the last page of this newsletter that we have a management team who support the different elements of work streams. Elaine C and Cate manage care and support, Charlotte – housing and Hannah – training, with Abby providing Admin support and Mandy Bookkeeping. We all work together to support the 'Human Resources' work of recruiting and managing staff while Lorna is on maternity leave. With the Lead Support Workers, we also provide a 24/7 on-call service for our service users and staff as well as having an open door at the office during working hours.

We work hard to recruit and retain staff with the right ethos, skills, knowledge, and experience. We take our time for them to get to know the service users and ways of work, and of course they have a number of training courses to complete. All staff new to support work complete the Care Certificate, and our Training Co-Ordinator runs courses so that staff can gain a qualification to further develop their knowledge. There is a recruitment crisis in social care, but I am proud to say that we are fully staffed with a waiting list of people wanting to join our staff teams.

Covid is still with us, however the government has decided this week that staff and visitors no longer need to wear masks when walking around the houses unless a service user has Covid. Masks will still be used for personal care and if a staff member or service user chooses to wear a mask. Please support us to keep Covid and other illnesses from the houses by continuing to respect personal distances and not coming to visit if you are unwell.

Thank you to everyone who has supported us during 2022, including our hard-working Trustees who give their time freely.

I look forward to seeing you all in 2023 and beyond.

My family is very important to me, and I adore seeing my mum once a week.




I love visiting cafes and restaurants wherever I go, whether it being around the local area or if I am away on day/overnight trips! I am especially partial to fish & chips.


















Ruth


We had a kit kat and diet coke party to remember Mark Bell.

I recently went on holiday to Towyn.










I enjoyed visiting the Zoo and meeting some animals.






John



I still enjoy a walk in the local park or woodland. And at present I am swimming twice a week!










Chris



I joined Chester Link in July, and I've settled in well to Lavender Place with Ruth!


I love my one to ones with my staff on weekends where I eat out and try lots of different foods.
